 - a. Travis suggested we give wristbands to LC Valley Young Life (Jim Stuck)
 - 11. At the June meeting a couple members were curious about the possibility of selling ducks PRIOR to the event. Ben explained this was looked at last year at the inaugural event but was nixed because of not having enough time to arrange a gambling license required by the State of Washington. Ben didn't think the cost was very much...but the approval process for the license took a considerable amount of time. <u>NEXT STEP:</u> Ben will follow up with Kyle who looked into the gambling license requirements and this will be discussed and finalized at July's meeting.
- C. Shoe Drive (Organizer: <u>Jeff</u>)
 - 1. Jeff has drafted a letter that he intends to send to a variety of shoe companies, to buy shoes on bulk discount.

- b. LC Crew is doing a \$100 tee sponsorship for the LCCU Miracle Scramble.
- c. Does anybody want to coordinate this for any other tourneys they have a strong interest in supporting??
- 2. Other possible ideas that LC Crew could contribute to:
 - a. Backpack Drive (Willie talked to Debbie O'Kelley and she said they don't need backpacks...they really need shoes).
 - b. Cattleman Scholarship Fund (Casey)
- 3. Scott suggested looking at doing a Kentucky Derby themed fundraiser. Some ideas discussed are below:
 - a. Scott pointed out there isn't really anything Kentucky Derby themed; however there are many folks in the valley that do house parties and smaller events for the weekend. Would probably have a decent following from locals.
 - b. Look at doing this at RoundUP grounds (either in the main arena or the indoor arena). The innagural event may need to take place in the Ketch Pen or the Saloon (smaller size). It was mentioned there used to be a big dance event prior to kicking off the Lewiston Roundup every year.
 - c. The derby could be shown on the big screen (or TV's if inside).
 - d. Scott will be the lead for this committee if it gains any traction.

E. Down the Road:

- 1. Casey suggested LC Crew consider buying livestock from 4-H. Casey and Dustin will work together on this.
- 2. Casey pointed out we need to plan ahead for Christmas "sponsor a family" and other holiday-season donations...
 - a. Stonebraker (Don and Bob) asks that instead of receiving birthday gifts that their employees provide donations to others on their behalf. They are looking for ideas...maybe something combined with LC Crew or parlay a donation.....
 - b. Ben will follow up with Debbie O'Kelley (Highland Elementary) who has good ideas for this.
 - c. Sam will follow up with New Bridges like he did the year before last.
